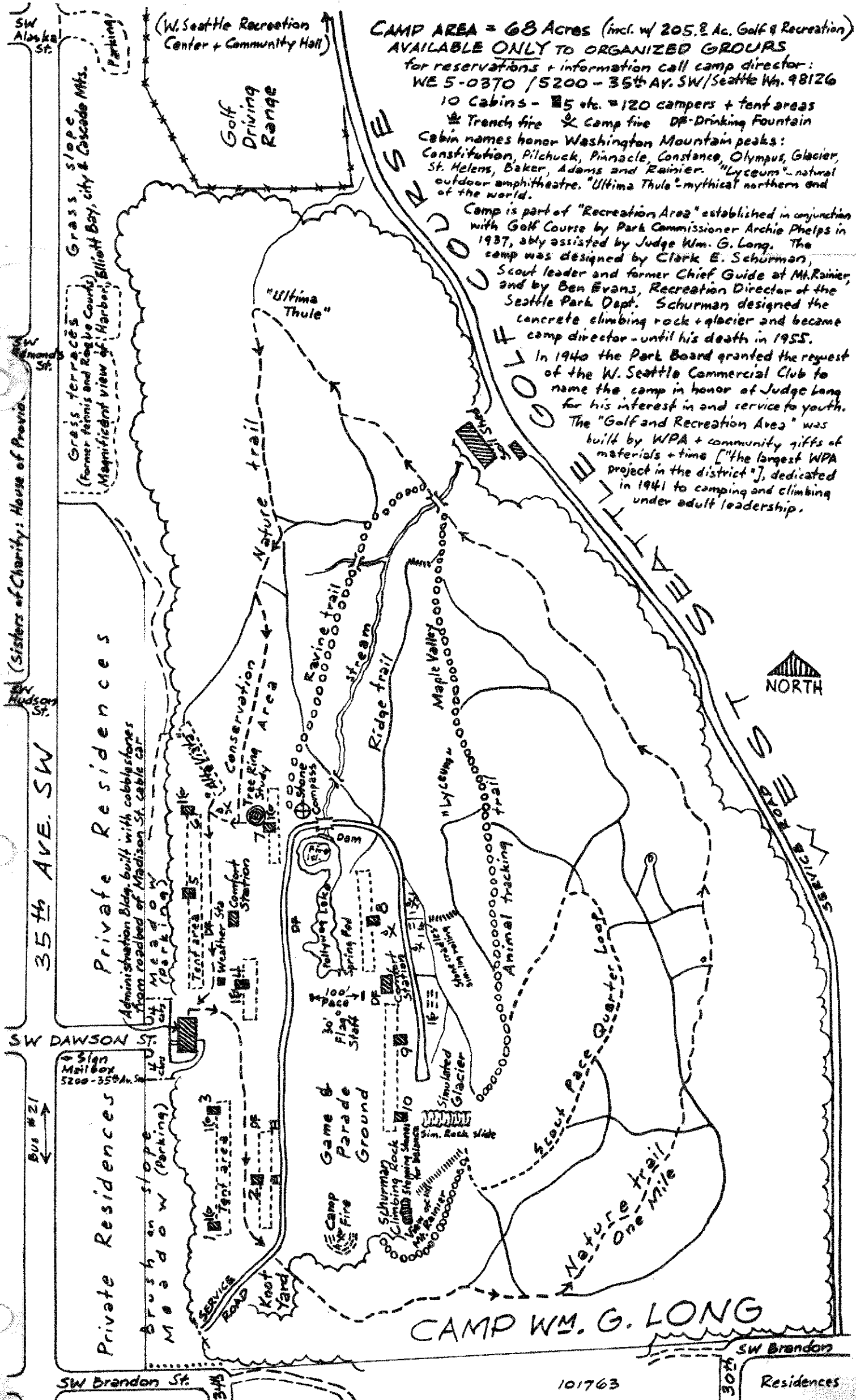

Cabin names honor Washington Mountain peaks: Constitution, Pilchuck, Pinnacle, Constance, Olympus, Glacier, St. Helens, Baker, Adams and Rainier. "Lyceum" - natural outdoor amphitheatre. "Ultima Thule" - mythical northern end of the world.

Camp is part of "Recreation Area" established in conjunction with Golf Course by Park Commissioner Archie Phelps in 1937, ably assisted by Judge Wm. G. Long. The camp was designed by Clark E. Schurman, Scout leader and former Chief Guide at Mt. Rainier, and by Ben Evans, Recreation Director of the Seattle Park Dept. Schurman designed the concrete climbing rock + glacier and became camp director - until his death in 1955.

In 1940 the Park Board granted the request of the W. Seattle Commercial Club to name the camp in honor of Judge Long for his interest in and service to youth.

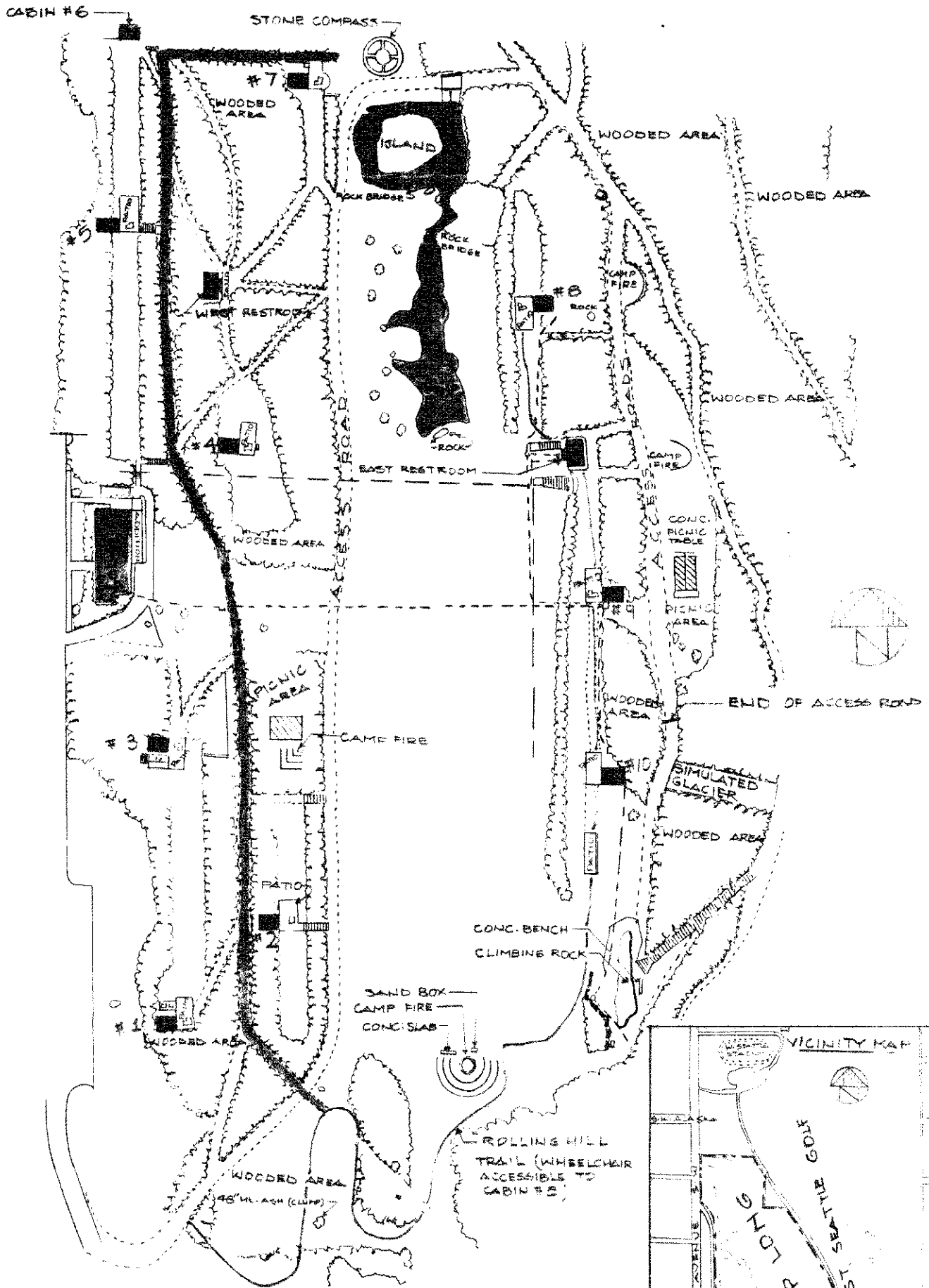

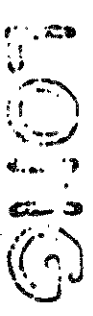

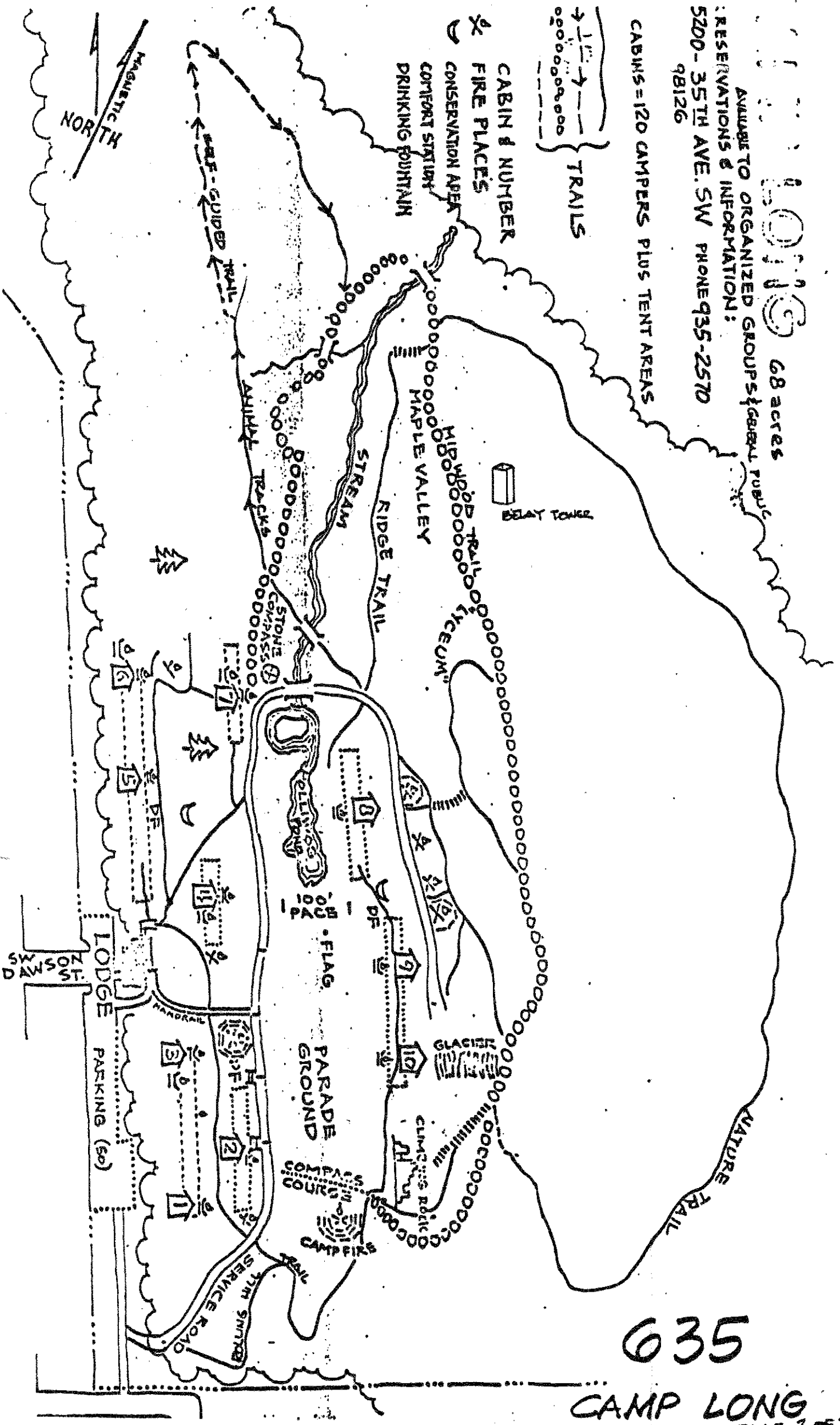
