

In a 1910 Resolution, Park Board agreed to maintain a public bathhouse between Mt. Baker + Seward Parks in consideration of a deed to 3000' of waterfront between Trotters Pt. + Bailey Peninsula. Unsuccessful attempt 1931 to move "unsightly, noisy" bathhouse to Seward, care north of Bathhouse.

(Oxler Island) Site of sawmill (1870s-80s); land grant of 350 acres to Chas. Waters (Wild Bird Sanctuary established - 1932 - here by D.E. Frederick who provided feed and shelter. Owing to neighborhood objections it was moved to the north end of Seward Park before his death in 1937. Ben Paris + Dr. Brien T. King took over project. It is now located in Green Lake.) (D.E. Frederick was co-founder of Frederick & Nelson Department store.)

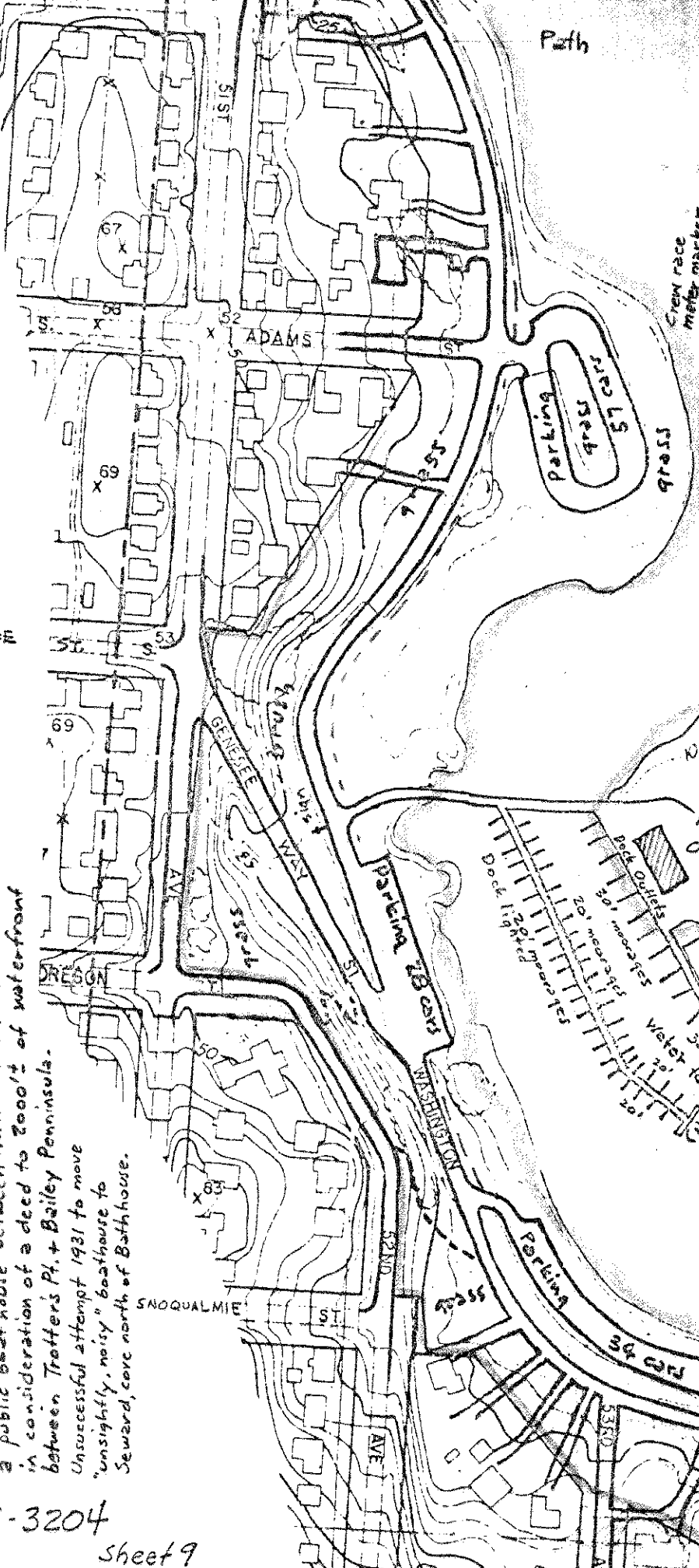
Unsuccessful attempt 1931 to move "unsightly, noisy" boathouse to Seward, cove north of Boathouse.

Frederick, who provided food and shelter. Owing to neighborhood objections it was moved to the north end of Seward Park before his death in 1937. Ben Paris + Dr. Brien T. King took over project. It is now located in Green Lake.) (D.E. Frederick was cofounder of Frederick & Nelson Department store.)
