## Overview

We're designing a better connection for people biking and walking between the business areas of South Park and Georgetown.

The neighborhoods are adjacent to each other but it's not easy to walk and bike between the two. We're committed to completing these improvements for people walking, biking, and rolling and connect the two neighborhoods.

## Background

The need for better connections between Georgetown and South Park was heard throughout community advocacy and past planning including: the Georgetown Mobility Study, Pedestrian Master Plan, Bike Master Plan, Freight Master Plan, Transit Master Plan, and Bicycle and Pedestrian Safety Analysis.

## Schedule

**2019:** Collected community input for early design

**2021:** Completed 30%, 60%, and 100% design

**2022:** Began environmental review

**2023:** Modified 100% design to include interim solution at E Marginal Way S and 16th Ave S

**2024:** Begin construction

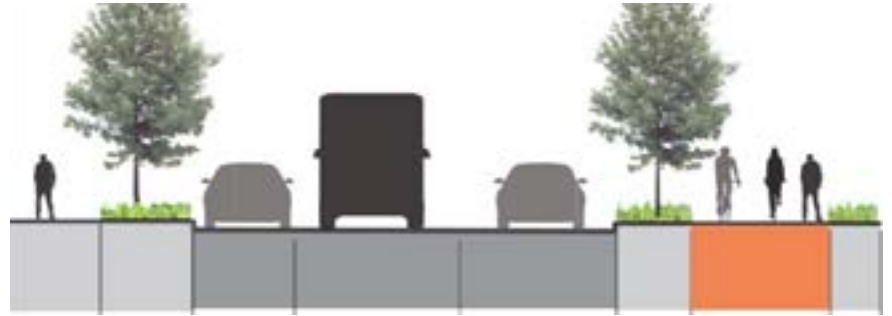
## Project Area

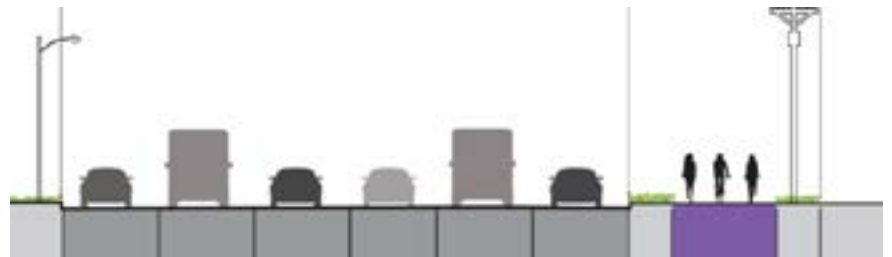
### Georgetown Connection

— Ellis, Albro, 13th: A walking and biking path on Ellis Ave S, S Albro Pl, and 13th Ave S



### E Marginal Way S Connection

— North side: A walking/biking path on the north side of E Marginal Way



### Interim change: SW side of E Marginal Way S & 16th Ave S

\* Instead of a concrete curb, the curb will be paint and post. Once the review and permitting process for this area is complete, we will install the concrete curb bulb from our original design.

### South Park Connection

— 16th Ave S: One-way protected bike lanes on both sides of 16th Ave S leading to the South Park bridge
