

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Wedgwood to Roosevelt neighborhood greenway will provide a safer connection for people walking and biking between the Wedgwood Neighborhood Greenway (39th Ave NE) and the Roosevelt neighborhood. The Wedgwood to Roosevelt neighborhood greenway will enhance safe access for students walking and biking to Roosevelt High School and the Northeast Branch Seattle Public Library. The greenway will connect people between protected bike lanes, an existing neighborhood greenway, future Roosevelt Light rail station, and the Burke Gilman Trail.

Project Schedule

Greenway elements construction will begin as soon as Summer 2020, crossing improvements of 15th Ave NE will be installed with the paving project <http://www.seattle.gov/transportation/15thNEpaving>

Construction Notice

We're planning a decorated intersection to highlight the connection to Ravenna-Eckstein Park and Community Center. Installation will allow local access only on NE 68th St from 20th Ave NE to Ravenna Ave NE and on 21st Ave NE from NE 70th St to NE 68th St during:

- July 14, Tuesday: 9:00 AM- 2:30 PM
- July 15, Wednesday: 9:00 AM-1:00 PM
