In 2017, the Seattle Department of Transportation added a two-way protected bike lane along the east side of Gilman Ave W, increasing safety and connectivity. Now, SDOT will improve the bus stops along the route to ensure they are accessible and reduce bicycle-transit conflicts. Here are the planned changes:



Raise the protected bike lane at bus stops.



Add marked crosswalks across Gilman Ave W at W Fort St, W Jameson St, W Elmore St, and W Emerson Pl.



Add an asphalt sidewalk on the east side of Gilman Ave W from W Jameson St to W Emerson Pl.



Add or improve curb ramps on Gilman Ave W at Fort/28th, Williams, Jameson/27th, 26th, Elmore/25th, 24th, and Emerson/Thurman.

These improvements are planned for Spring 2021, and are funded by the Levy to Move Seattle, approved by voters in 2015.
