- **\$9.95/month** unlimited internet (speeds up to 50Mbps) + tax.
 - No term contract or credit checks. *Free installation and in-home Wi-Fi are included.*
 - Eligible households must reside in an area serviceable by Comcast
 - **Not eligible if a household had Comcast Internet service within the last 90 days or has recent unpaid Comcast bills (less than one-year old).**
 - Eligibility includes households eligible for public assistance programs such as
 - National School Lunch Program
 - Public Housing Assistance
 - Medicaid / Supplemental Security Income (SSI)
 - Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP)
 - Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP)
 - Women, Infants, and Children (WIC) / Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF)
 - Refurbished desktop or laptop available for \$149.99 + tax.
