### **Digital Navigators**

Seven digital navigators + supervisor

#### Responsibilities:

- Laptop and/or iPad distribution with one-on-one instruction
- Register SHA residents for the SHA Portal and teach portal navigation
- Teach specialized classes such as coding and filmmaking
- Assisted residents with Affordable Connectivity Program enrollment
- Once ACP ended then assisted with low-cost internet options
- Taught Seattle Public Schools online portal navigation

## **Desktop Computer Labs**

Seven desktop computer labs

- Printer and wi-fi at each location
- All computers have Microsoft Word, PowerPoint, and Excel
- One computer lab (STAR Center) specially designed for people with disabilities

Available for (but not limited to) open lab, classes, and workshops

Previous class activities

Basic computer skills, photography, career readiness, and youth tutoring

## **Mobile Computer Labs**

Seven charging stations + MacBooks

Up to twenty laptops and five iPads at each station

All computers have Microsoft Word, PowerPoint, and Excel

Devices can be brought to locations without a permanent computer lab

Previous class activities

Basic computer skills, ESOL, coding for youth, filmmaking, SHA Portal
